- 4. Any crew that is entered to take part in a Fixed Head and is late to the start they will be automatically removed from the fixed head category and reallocated to the Timing Only category.
- 5. At least three crews/scullers from 2 different clubs must compete at each event in order for a pennant to be awarded.
