

Crews should row well into the basin before turning to join the queue. Later finishing crews must not cut across to 'jump' the queue

KEEP LEFT HEADING

UP INTO THE BASIN

Pass right up into the basin before turning to join the crews queuing for the slipways

ALBERT

All crews should return to the slip that they launched from

Crews should paddle through the finish, moving across and staying close to the road side of the canal

Beware of scullers returning to and queuing for the Green Pontoon

Safety launches will be managing traffic returning to the slips.

Please listen to and follow all instructions from the marshals

Be aware of the conditions when returning to the slips. Paddle gently from the basin, stay in the queue and keep tapping your boat against the breeze.

## USE BOTH SIDES OF THE PONTOONS / JETTY

The predicted southerly wind will be against you as you approach before turning your bows on to the pontoons
