The draw will be available immediately after the close of entries.


The timetable will rotate events using singles, doubles and quads in a rolling order to allow for change-overs – we are prioritising rowers to compete within their own age categories via the timetable. Rowers competing in more than one age category should be aware that clashes may occur. A draft timetable/race order will be published before the event.

## **Parking**

Trailer parking only will be available at the club – no other vehicles will be able to access the club grounds on the day of the event. A drop off point near the club will be in use via a one-way traffic system. Parking will be offsite a short walk from the club.
