Entries are made via Rowing Ireland Tracker System only. Entries will close at 7pm Wednesday 2nd August. The draw will be available immediately after the close of entries. The timetable will be published shortly after the close of entries.

Timetable/ Race Order

Masters races will take place on Saturday the 12th after the completion of the Junior Championship. Provisionally the first race will take place at 3.30pm*. Racing will then run off with 25 minutes between race start times.

Senior races will take place on Sunday the 13th August. Captains meeting 8am, first race 9am. The format will be the same as in previous years with two events on the course at the same time with a staggered start of 5 minutes between races.
