Event Overview

The 2024 Swift Racing Irish Senior Coastal Rowing Championships will be held at Bantry Aerodrome, Bantry, Co. Cork on the weekend of Saturday 24th and Sunday 25th August. Hosted by Bantry Rowing Club & the RI Coastal Committee, the event will be the second time Bantry RC will host the Senior championship. It will be the 8th year in a row a coastal event is taking place in the bay. Swift Racing are the continued sponsors for the event and we thank them for their continued support of rowing in Ireland.

All Rowing Ireland affiliated clubs and overseas clubs (who have a governing body affiliated with World Rowing) are invited to enter.

Event Summary

The following events will be offered at the Championship:

Men's Solo (CM1X) Men's Double (CM2X) Men's Coxed Quad (CM4X+)

Women's Solo (CW1X) Women's Double (CW2X) Women's Coxed Quad (CW4X+)

Mixed Double (CMix2X)

The event will be run under the Rowing Ireland Rules of Racing.

All events are raced over a course of approximately 4000m.

A pennant will be awarded to the winning crew in each category. Medals will be awarded to crews finishing in 1st, 2nd & 3rd.

Domestic entries are made via Rowing Ireland Tracker System only.
