Commercial Rowing Club invites entries for our Annual Regatta which will take place at Islandbridge on Sunday, April 2nd 2023.

- Entries close on Wednesday, 22nd March at 19:00, via the Rowing Ireland website.
- Racing will be side by side on two lanes over **1,200m** (1,000m for Junior 14s and Masters).
- Our regatta is designated **Non-Status** by the Rowing Ireland. Please see the 'Rules of the Regatta' below.
- It is recommended that each competitor enter a maximum of two events, where events are of the same group (see attached list of events). We've offered a wide selection of events in an effort to promote good competition. This may result in single entries in certain events. Therefore, we'd be grateful if clubs could provide a contact that will be available on the day following the entries close date, so that we can explore the possibility of moving single entries into alternative events.
- A club may not enter more than two crews in any given event, regardless of boat class.
- J14 and J15 events will be run as straight finals...
- **Results** will be available live on the day.
- Hot and cold food will be on sale throughout the day.

We look forward to welcoming you and your club to our regatta for what we hope will be a very successful and enjoyable event.

RULES OF THE REGATTA



- 1. The Regatta will be run under Rowing Ireland rules.
- 2. All entries must be made via Rowing Ireland's Tracker system.
- 3. Entry fees must be paid before crews' race. Cheques should be made payable to Commercial Rowing Club.
- 4. It is recommended that each competitor enter a maximum of two events, where events are of the same group (see attached list of events). Races are grouped such that any two events in the same group <u>will not clash</u> in the timetable. A competitor entering multiple races from different groups cannot be guaranteed their racing will not clash.
- 5. A club may not enter more than two crews in any given event, regardless of boat class.
- 6. Prizes will be presented to all winning competitors. As single entries for events will be eliminated at the Draw, there will be no row-overs.
- 7. Crews must observe Rowing Ireland rules in relation to notifying substitutions in crews.
- 8. The Regatta Committee reserve the right to make any alterations to the programme they deem necessary, and their decision in all cases will be final.
- 9. A copy of the Draw will be posted on the Rowing Ireland website as will a Safety Statement.
- 10. In the interests of safety and fair racing, crews on the course will obey the bank stewards' and umpires' instructions at all times and abide by 'Commercial Regatta Rules of the River' (see separate document). In accordance with Rowing Ireland rules, penalties equivalent to a False Start may be awarded for traffic violations.
- 11. Inexperienced crews should be accompanied by a Club Coach on the way to the start.
- 12. Races will be over the full course of 1,200m for all grades except Junior 14 and Masters which will be run over 1,000m. Junior15s please note this rule.
- 13. Commercial Rowing Club and Commercial Regatta Committee accept no liability or responsibility for any injury or damage to persons, property or equipment which may arise during the Regatta.
