

Commercial Regatta 2023

Time Trial Information

Sculling Time Trial:

- The sculling time trial will take place at **09:00am**
- All bow numbers must be collected from regatta control by **08:30am**
- **Bow numbers will have a €10 deposit.**
- The start list is available online and at the end of this document.
- The slips will be closed at **08:50am** so that no other boats will obstruct the sculling time trial, and opened again for crews to take to the river after the last sculler has passed the slips.
- All scullers must be at the start at **08:55am**
- The trial will be a rolling start, starting from the 1000m mark (just below the start, signified by the first fishing pontoon after the start)
- The finish line will be the regatta finish.
- Scullers will start the race and proceed around the corner to the boat house straight. **Scullers must row down the south station (Trinity Side) once around the final bend.** This will be reiterated at the start, and also by marshals during the race.
- Once a sculler has passed the finish they will turn and row back the **North station (Commercial, Neptune, UCD, Garda side)** to their slip.
- The two top scullers from each category will progress through to the final. These scullers will be announced over the PA system, and also updated on the live timetable once results are in.

Timed Heats:

- Categories where heats are timed are denoted on the timetable with the round number **TT**
- These heats will be raced as normal and timed (similar to Grand League), with the fastest two crews progressing to the final
- Crews will be timed off the start blocks.
- The starter will remind all crews that their event is a time trial heat before the start.
- Should there be an odd number of crews in an event, the final crew will race down off the start blocks alone with a time taken
- Should the conditions on the day be difficult (Such as strong flow), the racing shall be timed off a rolling start, with the start time being taken from the sculling time trial start line (1000m). This will be explained to crews by the starter should this take place.
