144th Dublin Metropolitan Regatta
Saturday 28th May 2022
Poulaphouca Reservoir, Knockieran, Blessington
Incorporating the Rowing Ireland Grand League Regatta Series.

The following are the conditions of entry to the regatta:

1. The Grand League Regatta is a full status regatta and will take place over a 6-lane course.
2. Events for masters crews / sculler will take place over a 1000m course from the start platforms.
3. All entries must be made through the Rowing Ireland tracker system.
4. Presentation medals will be presented to the winner of each category that contains two or more entries from at least two different clubs.
5. Where there are more than 6 entries for a masters event the event will be run as a series of finals with medals presented to the winner of each final.
6. Entries for the regatta close on Wednesday 18th May 2017 at 19.00hrs.
7. **Clubs must declare all crews intending to race at the regatta by 7.00pm on Thursday 26th May.** Declaration of crews/ scullers must be made through the Rowing Ireland tracker system.
8. The timetable for finals will follow the programme set out in the Grand League format for one day regattas and will not be altered. The sequence for the heats of events with more than 6 entries will follow the same sequence as that set out for finals.
9. Clubs entering individuals in more than one event should consult the GL programme provided in the regatta documentation on tracker system to ensure there is sufficient time between events to allow participation in all events entered.
10. The schedule for the masters events is also included in the regatta documentation uploaded to the tracker system.
11. There are no J14 or J15 events included in this years regatta programme. This is due to a need to keep the regatta to a manageable size and to ensure that all participants have a safe and enjoyable days racing. Clubs are asked not to enter J14 or J15 competitors in the other junior events on the programme unless they are competent to race at the level and over 2000 meters distance.
12. All boats to be used at the regatta must be fitted with Empacher type number slots close to the bow ball for attaching lane numbers.
