To Captains and Coaches of participating clubs;

Thank you for your entry for the 144th edition of Dublin Metropolitan Regatta. It is a great pleasure to hold the regatta this year after the two year break due to the Covid outbreak. It is the ambition of the Metro Council to run a safe and enjoyable event for all participant and volunteers. The Metropolitan Regatta Council remind all those attending the regatta that Covid is still present in the community and if you or any of your athletes or supporters display any symptoms of the virus or other illness they should not come to the regatta. In order to run a safe event, the Regatta Council insist that all rowers and others attending follow the instructions of the parking marshals and the slip stewards and on-course officials.

Clubs are reminded of the following:

- **Declarations of crews racing at the regatta must be made before Thursday 26th May 2022.**
- **Declarations can only be made through the Rowing Ireland Tracker System.**
- **The regatta secretary cannot make a declaration on the system after the cut off time.**
- **Only crews declared on the tracker system can race at the regatta.**

Club captains should read the regatta notes and bring them to the attention of their competitors especially the information regarding warming up, cooling down and traffic circulation pattern to be followed when on the lake.

Parking for towing vehicles and boat trailers will be in the regatta enclosure, all other vehicles are to be parked in the field directly ahead as you cross the bridge from the Blessington side.

All those attending the regatta are asked to respect the privacy of the residents of the area surrounding the regatta enclosure and of Blessington village. Please park in the designated car park. Clubs are asked to keep the area around their boat trailer free of litter and to remove any litter and boat and rigger wrapping material when they leave the regatta enclosure.

The Regatta Committee wish all participants a safe and enjoyable days racing.
