



LIMERICK REGATTA 2024

Dear Captain/Secretary,

Many thanks for your entry for Limerick Regatta. We look forward to providing you with some excellent racing over the weekend.

I would like to draw your attention to the following:

- **Declarations for all races must be made through Tracker before 19:00 on Thursday 18th.** [Declarations on Tracker open 48 hours before the cut-off time] Failure to do so will result in the removal of the crew/sculler from the starting list.
- For those with smartphones, the draw & results will be available on the following [link](#).
- Please note the following specific information for certain events:
 - J14, J15 & Masters events will have multiple finals. The winners of each final will receive prizes
 - Events with 17 or more entries will commence with 4 lane time trials with the fastest four crews advancing to the final. Should the number of scullers drop to 16 or less following declarations, those events will no longer have time trials but will have heats instead.
- Junior 14 and Masters events will be flying starts from 1000m to the finish. The crews should proceed beyond the normal start to wait for their race. When called, they should move onto the course in their lane but should not attach to the stakeboats. They will then paddle to the 1000m mark under the supervision of an umpire who will start then with a flying start.
- In view of the very tight schedule, it will not be possible to accommodate requests for race changes.
- The regatta field will be open from early on Friday morning and security will be in place on Friday and Saturday nights.
- Parking Restrictions will apply in the regatta field and the approach road. We suggest parking before the village (far side of the bridge) and to walk the pathway along the riverbank to the regatta enclosure. Distance 400m. There will be limited parking in a car park on the road to the regatta field but this is likely to fill early. We have also secured the use of a yard on the Mountpelier side of the bridge.
- Catering will be provided throughout the day. Please note that there is a drinking water tap in the regatta field near the catering tent. Another tap is located just inside the gate to the St Michael's compound.
- Please pay entry fees in advance using the details at the bottom of this letter.
