

The Course - Neptune Regatta

Course length is 1200 metres.

The START - is from stakeboats located at the area known as the Big Bay (and the Boo House Bend)

The Finish Line - is at the end of the UCD Slipway just before the weir.

The course has 3 correcting buoys as indicated on the map below. As per the RI Rules of Racing,

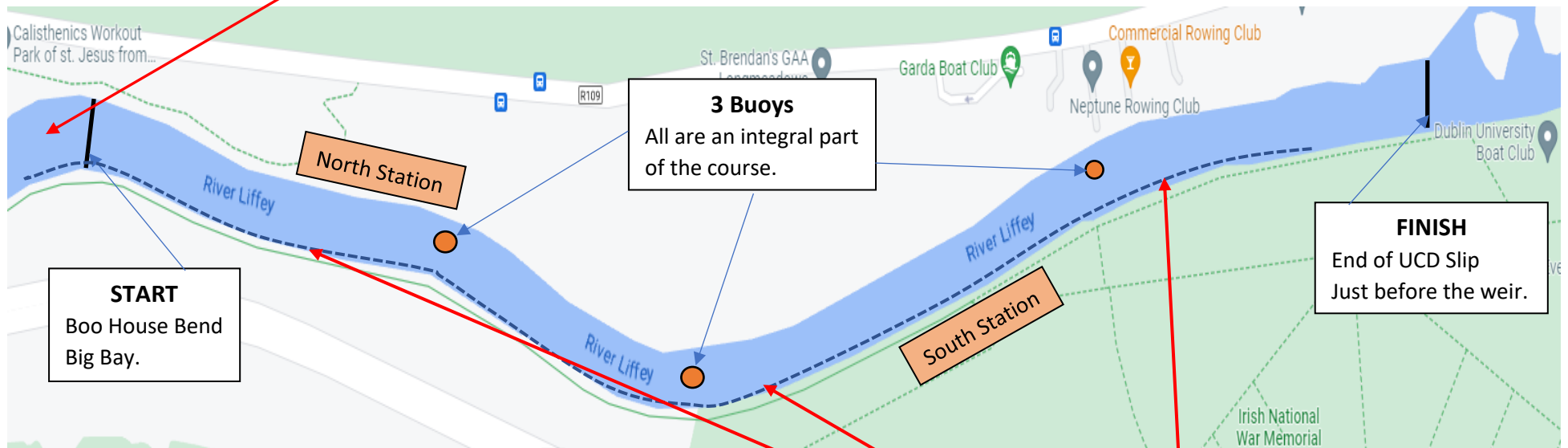
- All 3 buoys are an integral part of the course (this does not apply to coxless crews)
 - The blades of the crew must **NOT** touch the buoy.
 - All crew blades must pass the buoy within the station assigned to the crew as per the draw.

In preparation for your race, please launch 30 mins before your scheduled race time and note as follows:

- Please do not cross over to the other station until the river is clear.
- Proceed to the Start along the South Station (see map below)
- Make your way to the holding area and wait to be called for your race.

The main Holding Area is located behind the START



All Crews should be aware of the following:

- Proceed to the start along the South Station - as indicated by the dotted line.
- Pull in close to the bank and stop rowing when a race approaches.
- Follow the direction of the Marshals.
- Proceed to the holding area beyond the start and wait to be called for your race.
