

RIUB Newry Head of the River 2022

CORONAVIRUS ARRANGEMENTS

Newry Head will be a completely outdoor event (there are no buildings on the site to enter) and gazebos etc. can expect to be extremely well (naturally) ventilated. The numbers participating will also be well spread out across the site. The risk of Coronavirus transmission is therefore deemed minimal but the following arrangements (including the RI Covid Health declaration) will apply:

- Hand sanitation stations will be available.
- Participants should observe appropriate social distancing and avoid congregating in tight groups for any length of time.
- The event committee has appointed a Covid Officer for the event who will monitor activity and ensure appropriate Covid precautions are followed.
- All clubs must appoint a Covid Officer to help ensure their members abide by the appropriate arrangements.
- Everyone will be expected to follow Public Health and Rowing Ireland guidelines regarding Coronavirus.

Please make sure everyone travelling to the event from your club is aware of these arrangements.

Additionally, each club must provide RI Ulster Branch with a signed declaration (a Rowing Ireland covdoc2 form) confirming that a coronavirus health screening has been conducted and that, to the best of the Club Covid Officer's knowledge, no one travelling to the event (e.g. participants, coaches, spectators, volunteers) is suffering from or displaying any signs or symptoms of Covid-19.
