The Ulster Branch of Rowing Ireland is delighted to announce the return of Newry Head to the rowing calendar in 2022. Two races will be held over an approximately 5K course on Newry canal from Victoria Lock and finishing at Newry Rowing Club at the Albert Basin close to the centre of the town.

The categories available in each race are set out below. Due to capacity restrictions, we are unable to offer as many events as we would like this year with racing is primarily focused on fours and quads. We may be required to cap the number of crews in each race which may involve restricting clubs to one entry, per category per race.

In addition, to enable maximum participation, clubs must not enter the same rowers in crews in both races.
