Important Race and Launch details:

Any boat without correct bow number on both sides will not be permitted to race! The Timers are not able to identify the crew without this in place.

Racing

Proceed to hold zone, you will be called to start racing. Timing begins once you cross the start line. Times will be posted after each race. Please note phone coverage are poor in the area. Pennants awarded to winners of each category over the course of the day.

Declarations: All entries will be assumed to be racing unless the regatta secretary is notified or withdrawn on the day. s

ATHLETES: Civil Defence Ambulance onsite.

BOATS: All boats will be checked for safety prior to each launching to check PDFs, heel straps, And tow ropes.

Boats are numbered correctly on both sides.

Competent Athletes are only permitted on the racecourse.

Safety stewards' boats will be always on the course. The course will be monitored throughout the event for any hazards/crews going off course and weather conditions.
