We sincerely thank you for making the long journey and hope you have a successful day.

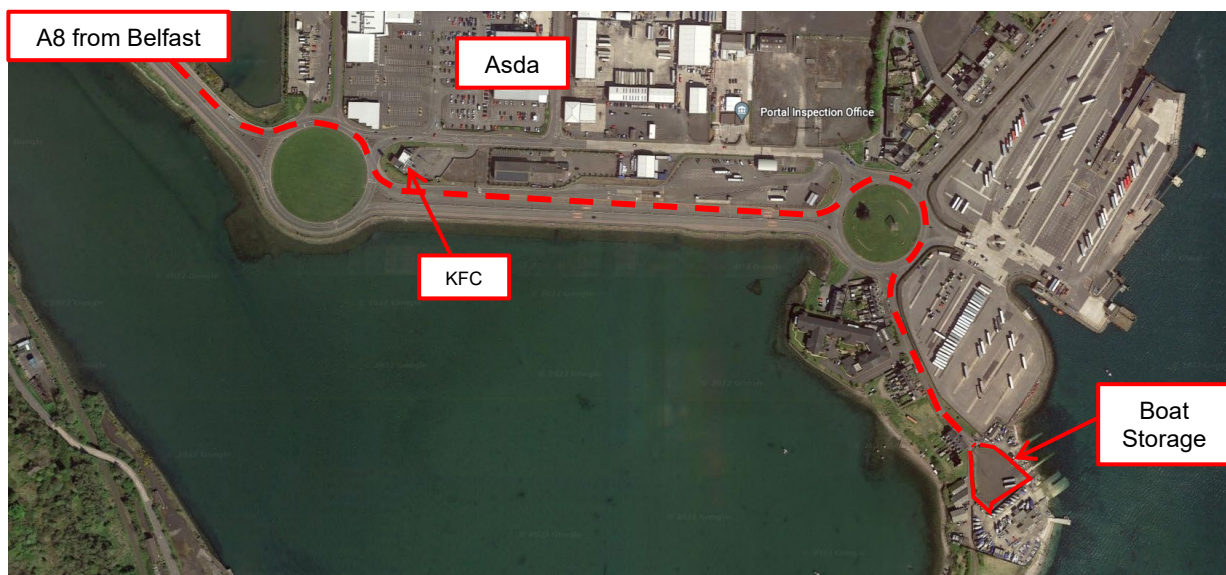
Race Information

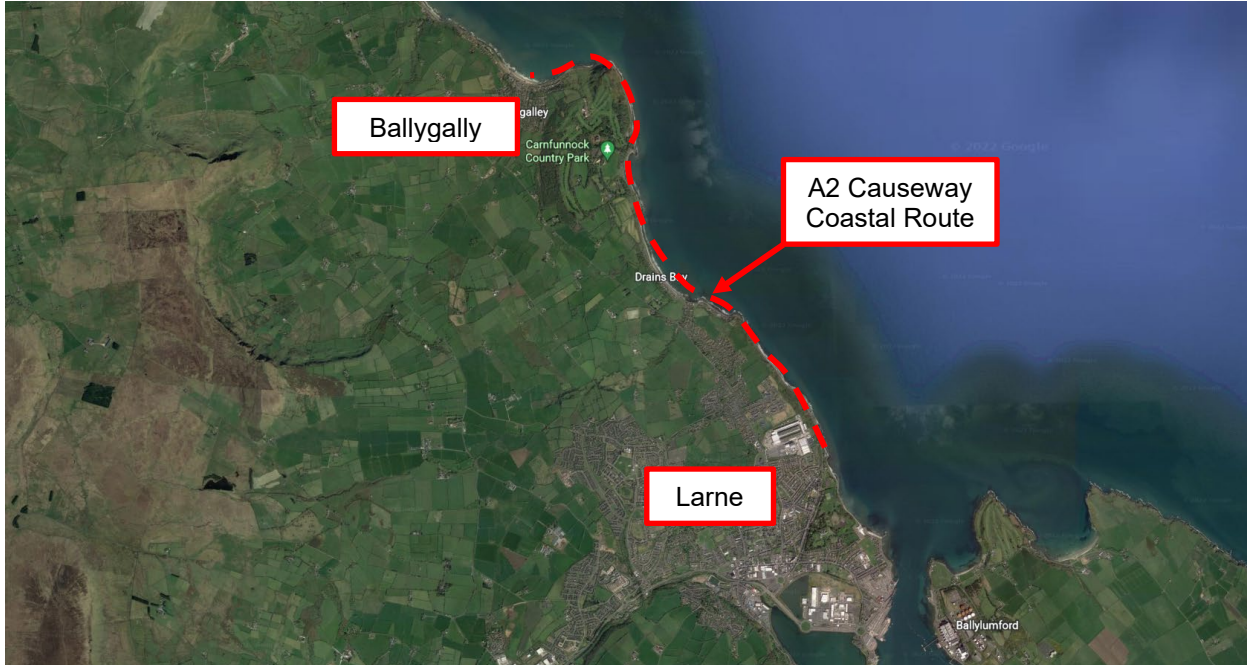

- Shop, Catering, Hall & Toilets

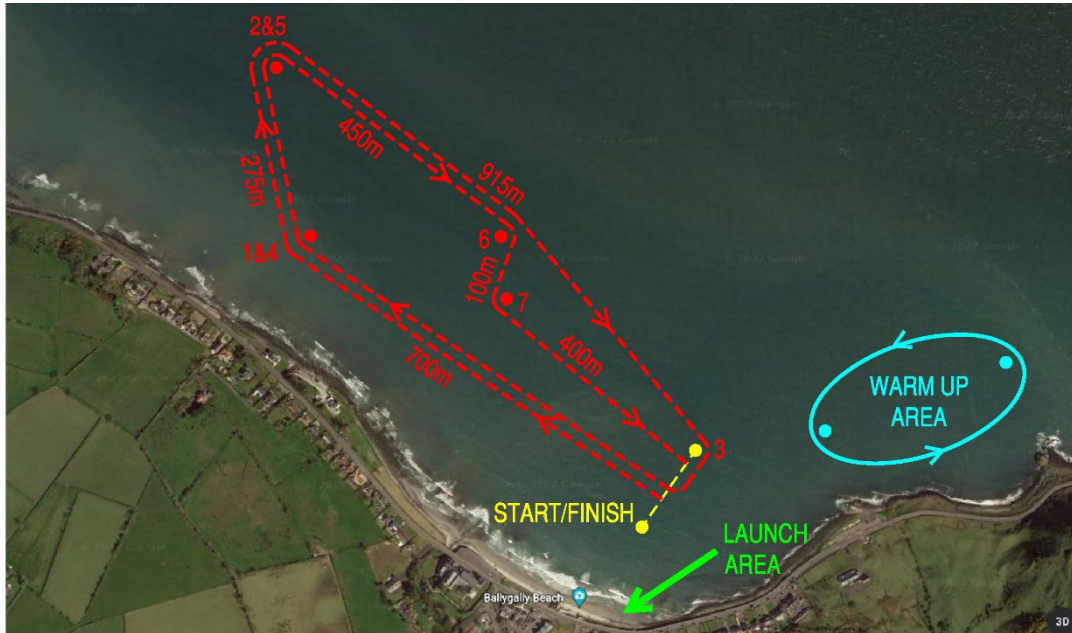

Course Maps & Co-ordinates

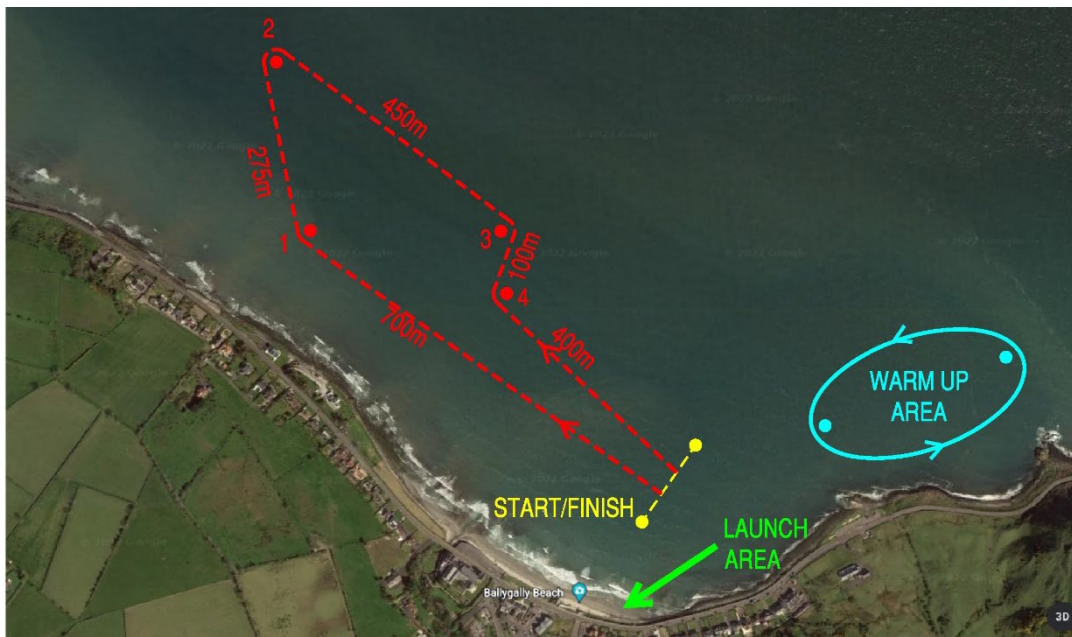
4000m Masters Course (3820m)
