For any club arriving on Friday 3rd May 2024 boats can be left I the boat park in Glenarm, there will be security present throughout the night.




If you are arriving before 3rd we can provide secure boat storage at our premises on Coastguard Road, Larne, see the map below. This facility will also be available on Saturday evening.
