## Swift Racing Irish Senior Coastal Rowing Championships 2024 Overseas Entries

Entries from overseas crews are permitted in the Swift Racing Irish Senior Coastal Rowing Championships 2024.

Entry is permissible from clubs who meet the following criteria:

- Entries are submitted and paid prior to the 14th August at 19:00. Entries can be sent to <a href="mailto:info@hurleyfitnessandtherapy.com">info@hurleyfitnessandtherapy.com</a>.
- Entry must include: Events entered, Athlete Names, Athlete Dates of Birth, Cox identified on crew when applicable. Entries should be laid out in a clear and concise manner. See example/template below.
- Entries from composite crews are permitted with a maximum of TWO clubs represented in line with Rowing Ireland Championship Rules. Entries should only come from one club with both clubs listed on the entry form. Entry fees are liable from the club making the entry.
- The club and the clubs governing body are affiliated to World Rowing (Fisa) and are able to provide documentation to prove this as required.
- Overseas crews bringing their own boats contact the regatta secretary prior to the close of entries to ensure a correct bow number is allocated. (All boats at Rowing Ireland Championships require a racing number, a number may need to be allocated and placed on the boat at your own expense).

## Entry fees are as follows:

- Solo 20.00 Euro
- Double 40.00 Euro
- Coxed Quad 80.00 Euro.

Entries to be made by the close of entries via Electronic Funds Transfer Only in one single payment. The amount due is as per your Tracker Total.

Entries are not considered complete by the host club without full payment.
