145th Dublin Metropolitan Regatta Saturday 27th May 2023 Poulaphouca Reservoir, Knockieran, Blessington Incorporating the Rowing Ireland Grand League Regatta Series.

Dear Secretary, Captain,

Dublin Metropolitan Regatta Council welcome entries for the 145th running of the event. The R.I. tracker page is now open for entries for both Grand League and Non-Grand League events. Club captains and coaches making entries for the regatta should consider the following points before completing the entry.

- The regatta will be organized in seven blocks of races GL heats and finals for morning and afternoon events and Non GL events for Master's and J14 and J15. (See Regatta Race Schedule)
- GL heats where required will follow the same sequence as the schedule set out for finals.
- The regatta program will not be altered from the published schedule. Competitors should not enter more than one event is any of the blocks of events.
- All races including Non GL 1000m events will be raced from the start platforms.
- All clubs entering boats at the regatta should ensure that the competitors being entered, including coxes, have the necessary rowing and boat handling skills to participate at the regatta.
- All boats entered at the regatta and intending to race must be declared on the RI tracker system by Thursday 25th May at 19.00hrs.
- Entry fees must be paid for all boats entered at the regatta.
- Part payment for composite crew rowers will not be accepted.

Entry fees are as follows:

Grand League Events	€12.00 per seat.
Masters Events	€10.00 per seat.
Junior (1000m) Events	€8.00 per seat.

Cheques should be made payable to Dublin Metropolitan Regatta Council and posted to the Regatta Secretary C/o Neptune Rowing Club. Bank details for clubs wishing to pay electronically will be posted to Tracker later.
