

### **Trailer parking and vehicle access Ashe Quay Fermoy**

No vehicular traffic will be allowed on the quays below Abbey Street from 5pm Saturday eve of regatta. Barrier access at point A. Access to boat trailers only – vehicles are then required to leave the boat area.

No vehicular traffic will be allowed on the quays below Pearce Square from 3am Sunday morning of regatta. Barrier access at point B. Access to boat trailers only – vehicles are then required to leave the boat area.



In advance of the regatta weekend each property/tenants are individually advised of the upcoming event with restricted parking in place for boat trailers. ALL properties that have access to Forge Lane – Rear of McCurtain Street – Ashe Quay – Abbey Street are contacted as well.

Fermoy Municipal Office will be notified in writing in advance of the event for permission.

The regatta committee will erect ample and visible notices of restricted parking for regatta day.

An Garda Siochana are written to in advance of the event for the purpose of giving passing attention during the time of the regatta
