The 2025 Swift Junior Coastal Rowing Championships will be held at Narin Beach, Portnoo Saturday 26th July 2025 hosted by Loughros point rowing Club on behalf of Rowing Ireland.

Event Categories

All above categories are championship events that will be held over a 2,200m course.

Coxswains: The minimum age for all coxswains of junior crews is 18 years of age on the day of the competition, i.e. their 18th birthday must have fallen on or before the day of the race.

Single Crew Finals

In the event that only one crew enters an event, or should all crews other than one withdraw, that event will not be deemed a Championship, and no prizes will be awarded.

Overseas Crews

The Junior Championship shall not be open to overseas crews.

Declarations and Scratches

Declarations and Scratches

All entries will be assumed declared, unless the regatta secretary is informed of a crew scratch prior to the captain's meeting. During the event all scratches must be submitted in writing to regatta control. There will be no refunds for scratches.

Timetable

The race timetable will be made available after the close of entries.

Captains meeting

There will be a captains meeting on the beach prior to racing commencing. Each club must be represented at this meeting.

Safety

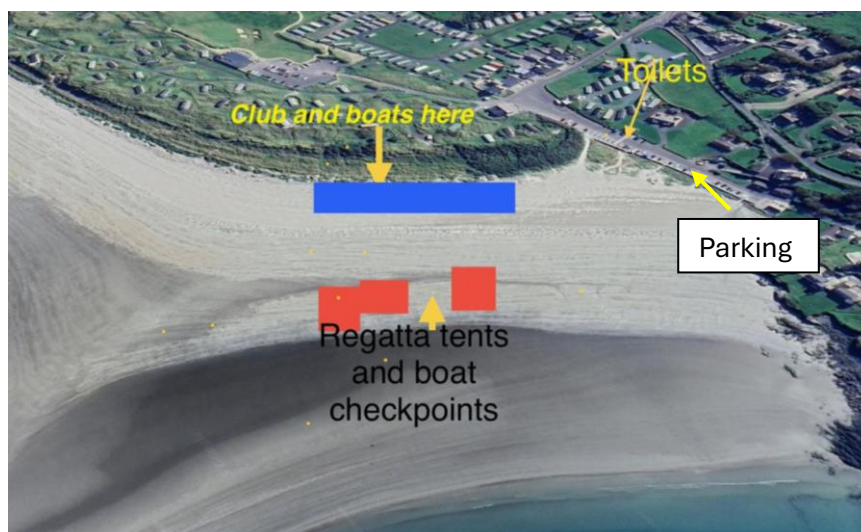
All participants and club captains must familiarize themselves with the safety statement for the event. It is the responsibility of each participating club to ensure that their participants are competent to compete, know what to do in the event of a capsize and wear appropriate clothing for the weather conditions.

Medical Assistance

Trained medical personnel will be present during the event and will remain onsite for the duration of the event. There is a Defibrillator in a wall-mounted cabinet outside the public toilets at the carpark.

Location, Access & Parking

The event is well signposted from nearby towns. Parking will be in the field adjacent to the beach as shown below. Please note carparking is free but space is limited to a first come first serve basis.
