



## Trinity Regatta 2023 – Single Sculls Time Trial Instructions

Given the large entry of single sculls in Trinity Regatta 2023, a 1000m time trial will be held for the following sculling events on Saturday morning in lieu of heats:

- Men's Intermediate 1x
- Men's Club 1x
- Men's Masters 1x
- Men's Junior 18 1x
- Men's Junior 16 1x
- Women's Junior 16 1x

The fastest four scullers from each category will be entered into the main draw. If a rower is entered in more than one sculling event, he/she will race the time trial once and their time will count for both events.

Bow numbers will be provided to each competitor and will be available to collect from regatta control from 6:30am. A ten-euro deposit will be collected on all bow numbers, refundable upon their return to regatta control. Each competitor will also be provided with a number to display on their back.

The start of the time trial will be the second fishing platform after the "Boohouse" Bend. The finish of the time trial will be approximately 200m downstream of Commercial RC, marked with a white flag on the south bank.

Single scullers should be assembled above the bay by 9:05am. The time trial will start at approximately 9:10am. Scullers will row through the start at approximately 30 second intervals.

Once scullers have finished their race, they should continue rowing downriver towards the weir to keep the course clear. Scullers must not interfere with other scullers when returning to their slip.

We will be using <u>www.raceclocker.com</u> for the time trial. We will also have a manual timing system as a back-up.
