Galway Regatta 2023 700 METER – 3 LANE SPRINT COURSE

Dear Secretary / Captain,

The 138th Galway Regatta will be held on **Saturday 3rd June 2023** on the Menlo Straight on the River Corrib.

All events are available on Rowing Ireland's Tracker system and only online entries will be accepted. The system will only accept entries from competitors registered for the 2023 season.

Under *No Circumstances* will entries be accepted by any other means and no late entries will be accepted.

Entries close on Tracker on Wednesday 24th May at 7:00pm. All entries must be received before then. A copy of the draw will be made available on Tracker.

We ask competing clubs to be mindful of the Conditions of Entry and to read and understand them carefully to avoid disruption and clashes during the event.

Note: this year all boats will be given bow numbers leaving the slip (see point 10 below).

Conditions of Entry:

The following entry conditions apply:

- 1. Entries are accepted subject to the rules of Rowing Ireland.
- 2. The Regatta is **Non-Status**.
- 3. Where a club enters 2 boats in a single event and where **NO OTHER CLUB** enters this same event, the event will **NOT** go ahead.
- 4. Cheques are to be made payable to **Galway Regatta Committee.** Online bank details also provided.
- 5. Entries close on **Wednesday 24th of May at 7:00pm**. Draw will be available online later that week.
- 6. Clubs and Competitors take part at their own risk.
- 7. Junior 14 and J15 events will be run off as straight finals.
- 8. We ask clubs to help play their part and to be mindful, when making their entries, to avoid boat, crew, sculling and sweep clashes, within your entry. The committee will not be in a position to cater for event changes on the day.
- 9. Limited to 3 events for Juniors, 2 events for Masters/Adults.
- 10. All boats will be assigned a **Race Number** on leaving the slip, so ensure all boats are fitted with number slots. The Starter, Umpires and Race Judge will use these bow numbers to identify crews for their race at the start area, and at the finish i.e. Galway A, Athlone B, Castleconnell B etc. Coaches ensure your crew has the correct bow number on leaving the slip.
- 11. Please note that due to volunteer commitments, all Masters Women races will be rowed in the morning, while Masters Men events will be rowed in the afternoon. There will be no exceptions to this.
- 12. Boats must have bow balls and heel restraints, which will be checked before reaching the slipway. Boats deemed safe will be tagged as such for the day's racing. Number Slots also required due to Race Numbers being used for all races.
- 13. Competing clubs are responsible for protecting their property and are encouraged to take out adequate insurance cover. The Regatta Committee cannot be held accountable for loss or damage to property.
