Clubs arriving on Friday, 9th May, may store boats in the Glenarm boat park, with overnight security provided.

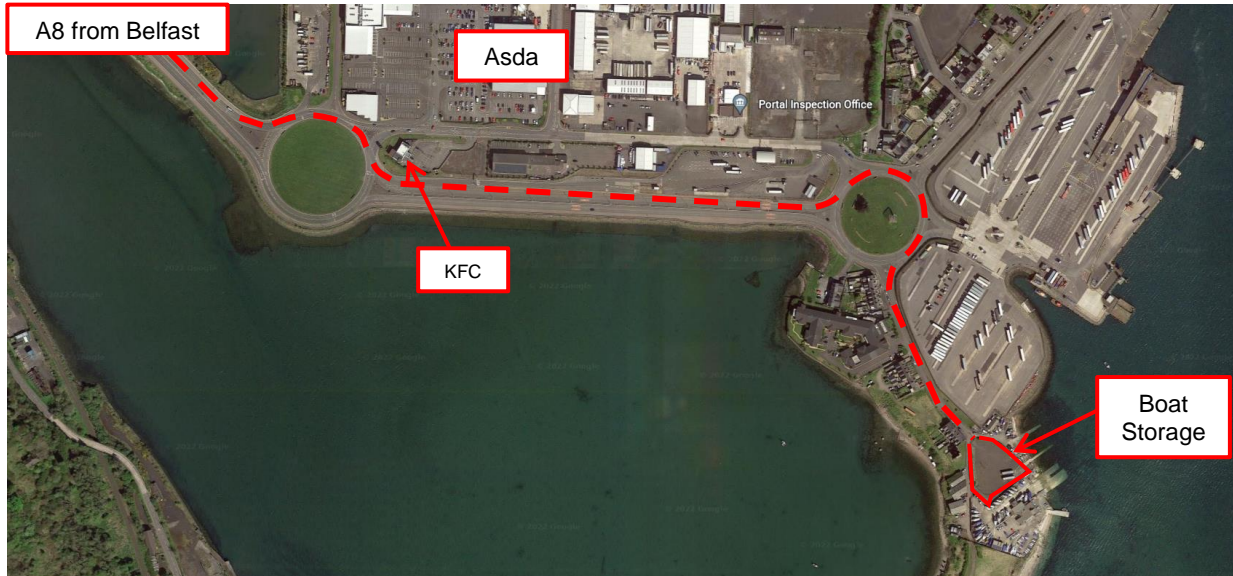

If arriving before 9th May, secure boat storage is available at our Coastguard Road premises in Larne. This facility will also be available on Saturday evening.



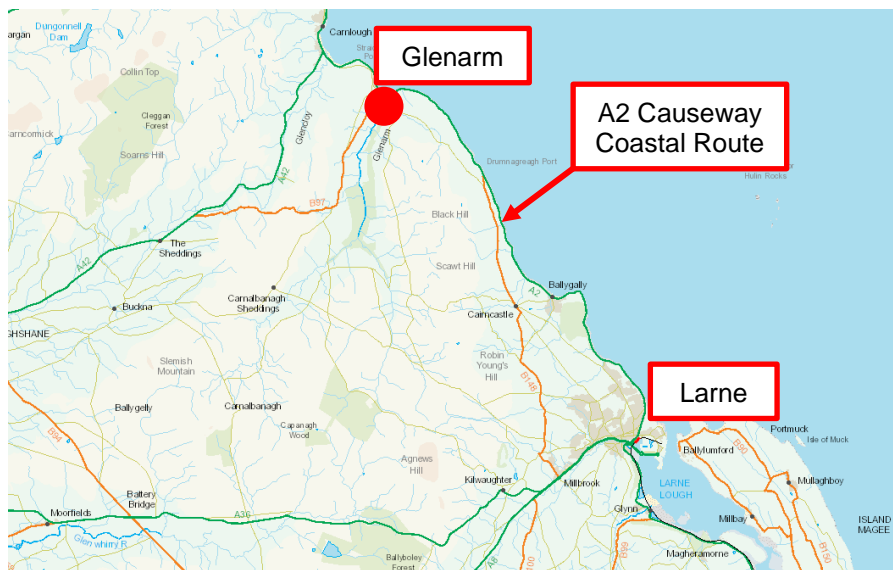

- █ Pontoons - Crew changes can take place here. Boats may be tied up at owners' risk (ropes and fenders are NOT supplied).

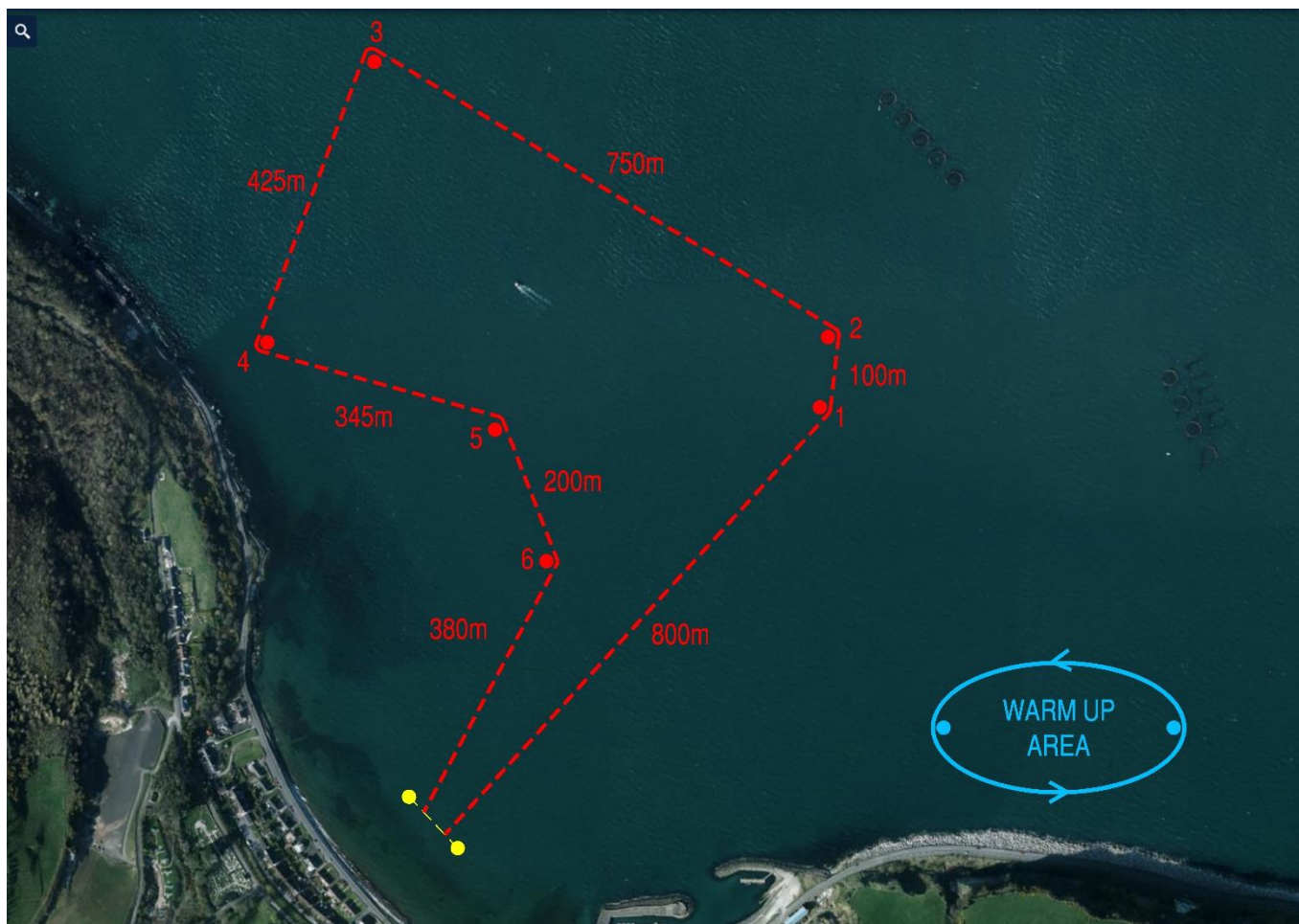
