

Swift Irish Coastal Championships 2023

Events Offered

The following events will be offered at the 2023 Swift Irish Coastal Championships.

Heats will take place on Saturday 29th for all events which require them. Finals will take place on Sunday the 30th.

Junior quad races will be raced over the full 4k course. Junior 16 races will be raced over a 2k course.

All entries must be made via the Rowing Ireland Tracker System. Entry is only open to registered members of clubs affiliated to Rowing Ireland.

Entries will close at 7pm Wednesday 19th July.

The same race order will be followed for the heats on Saturday and for the finals on Sunday.

Heats for an event will take place back to back, e.g. Heat 2 of CW2X will take place directly after Heat 1 of CW2X. The race order will not be changed unless there are exceptional circumstances (e.g. weather).

Clubs are responsible for ensuring they have sufficient equipment for all crews entered. Finals will take place at finals time on the Sunday 30th even if heats are not needed for a specific event.

Progression System

The maximum numbers allowed on the start line in any race will be 12 crews. Should this number be exceeded in any event there will be heats on Saturday.

The number to qualify from each heat will be published on the live draw/results sheet.
