



# IRISH SCHOOLS REGATTA 2025 O'Briensbridge, Co. Clare

Dear Captain/Secretary,

The Irish Schools Regatta is being run in O'Brien's Bridge on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> April, the day following Limerick Regatta.

## PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING POINTS:

- 1. The Regatta will be run under the Rules of Rowing Ireland.
- 2. This is a Non Status Regatta.
- 3. Entries through Tracker close on Wednesday, 16th April, at 19:00.

4. The draw will take place automatically on Tracker and should be visible as soon as entries close.

5. It is recommended that individuals row in only one event in the morning and evening session

6. We have offered Under 23 rather than Junior 18 events to cater for those school students who are no longer eligible to compete at the latter grade (note – composites are not permitted).

7. Events offered are to maximise the number of rowers who can take part, whilst maintaining a timetable that will allow for those travelling to be home at a reasonable hour.

8. Please note that clubs may only enter two scullers in the U23 & J16 Single and double Scull events.

9. Heats will be held in the same order as the finals, where possible. Please see below for the list of events and the order and approximate timetable for the finals. Whilst we will attempt to adhere to the order shown, the Regatta Committee reserves the right to alter/amend the Regatta Programme if necessary.

10. This is a 4-lane buoyed 1,500m course. Junior 14 events will be flying starts 1,000m from the finish.

11. Junior 14 events will consist of straight finals. Other events with 16 entries or less will consist of heats and a final. If more than 16 crews declare, there will be time-trials with the fastest 4 crews advancing to the final.

12.Entry fees are as follows:- Eights €90, Fours/Quads €45, Pairs/Doubles €24, Singles €13

13.It is the policy of the Schools Regatta Committee that if the regatta is cancelled for whatever reason, we will give a full refund of all entry fees received.
